<p>Facility Sedation Permit – Level 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sedation using nitrous oxide and oxygen 	\$150
<p>Facility Sedation Permit – Level 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sedation using parenteral (i.e., IV) moderate and/or deep sedation. (These facilities are also permitted to administer sedation using nitrous oxide and oxygen.) 	\$300
