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**ORDER OF THE COMPLAINTS COMMITTEE**

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Before the Complaints Committee of the Nova Scotia Regulator of Dentistry and Dental Assisting (“NSRDDA”):

**WHEREAS** on May 11, 2026, a complaint was lodged against Dr. Christopher Whiting (the “Complaint”);

**AND WHEREAS** on June 8, 2026 the Complaints Committee met to determine whether to exercise its powers under s. 89 of the *RHPA*;

**AND WHEREAS** the Complaints Committee further determined that there are reasonable and probable grounds to believe that Dr. Christopher Whiting is exposing or likely to expose the public, patients, and the profession to harm or injury;

**AND WHEREAS** the Complaints Committee further determined that intervention is required prior to the disposition of the matter by the Complaints Committee or the Professional Conduct Committee;

**AND WHEREAS** the Complaints Committee further determined that a suspension was the appropriate intervention in the circumstances;

**IT IS ORDERED** that:

- a) Dr. Christopher Whiting’s license is hereby suspended until ordered otherwise by the Complaints Committee or the Professional Conduct Committee; and
- b) The Registrar shall provide notice of suspension on the NSRDDA website pursuant to s. 137(2) of the *RHPA*.
